

RESUBMISSION POLICY: POSTGRADUATE

1. Within the Masters programmes, a B- (2.7) grade is regarded as a 'redeemable fail'. Graduate students receiving this grade for a component of a course may re-submit the work to a time-frame agreed with the course instructor.
2. Students must advise the instructor of their intention to re-submit and obtain a revised submission date within five (5) working days of receiving the grade.
3. Marks for re-submitted material are capped at B.

RESUBMISSION OF FAILED THESIS/DISSERTATION OR PROFESSIONAL RESEARCH PROJECT

4. Grades of B- (2.7) on the thesis/dissertation or professional research project are treated as a "redeemable fail". Students are permitted one further opportunity to re-work the material based on written feedback and re-submit the thesis/dissertation or professional research project within one year of the original submission.
5. Students must advise the instructor and Associate Dean of their intention to re-submit within five (5) working days of receiving the grade.
6. Marks for the resubmitted material are capped at a B grade.
