

GRADING POLICY, POSTGRADUATE

General Principles

- 1. Overall final grades for courses are assigned by instructors at the end of every semester or summer session. All grades are subject to confirmation at the Formal School Exam Boards and University Exam Board.
- 2. Each letter grade is assigned a numerical equivalent on the following scale for **postgraduate** study:
