

## **INDEPENDENT STUDY PROJECT (ISP): UNDERGRADUATE**

## Introduction

1. An Independent Study Project (ISP) is an individual research, laboratory, or creative arts project, taken under the direct supervision of a permanent faculty member.

## **General Principles**

- 2. ISPs are set at FHEQ Levels 5 or 6 to fulfil credit shortfalls for degree-seeking students or Study Abroad students.
- 3. An ISP may not duplicate the curriculum of another course at the University.
- 4. An ISP requires in-depth academic work on a specialised topic; and involves research, reading, writing, and where appropriate, experimentation.
- 5. Students wishing to pursue an ISP must normally have a minimum of 56 US/224 UK credits, a GPA of at least 3.0, and a clean disciplinary record.
- 6. To arrange for an ISP, students must:
  - a. receive authorisation of need for ISP from Registry who will provide an authorisation form detailing the credit requirement
  - b. contact Academic Advisor and Head of Department to identify a suitable supervisor;
  - c. define the project and obtain the faculty supervisor's approval of the topic before the end of the preceding semester
  - d. send completed authorisation form to Registry.
- 7. The course is graded and carries 1-2 US/ 4-8 UK credits based primarily upon formal instructional time, for example: 1 credit: 1000 words, 2 credits: 2000 words. The determination of credit should not be decided by the faculty supervisor, this should entirely depend on credit need and decided by registry.
- 8. Supervision hours are detailed in the relevant syllabus for the course, in line with standard contact hours per credit as defined by the University.
- 9. Faculty supervisors accrue either workload points or are compensated on a per credit basis.

10. **Special note:** An ISP from another institution will not be accepted by the University as transfer credit. (See Undergraduate Transfer Credit Policy).
