Introduction

This document sets out the list of minors currently on offer at Richmond. Completing a minor is rewarding and allows you to gain expertise in an additional area; and this may lead to exciting career opportunities.

An undergraduate may complete the requirements of one major and one minor and receive one US degree. A minor is an optional subject of specialisation within the undergraduate degree, which must be outside of the undergraduate major course of study and consist of at least 12 US /48 UK credits. A minor may not be completed independent of an undergraduate degree.

A UK degree will show all courses (modules) undertaken by a student in their Academic Transcript but the Degree Certificate will only state the Programme Title (major subject specialisation). The Minors policy does not apply to UK-only top-up degrees.

Undergraduates who add a minor to their major degree programme will normally <u>not</u> need to complete more than the minimum 120 US/480 UK credits required for graduation. The normal course load for a full-time undergraduate student is 16 US/64 UK credits a semester. The minimum full-time undergraduate course load is 12 US/48 UK credits a semester.

All courses required for a minor must be completed at the University. No more than one course (4 US/ 16 UK credits) may overlap within a degree between a student's major, Liberal Arts Core and any minor. Upon graduation, any minor successfully completed is recorded on the student transcript alongside the major.

The University reserves the right to cancel or replace programmes and/or courses for which there is insufficient enrolment or concerns about academic standards, or for which the University cannot provide adequate teaching resources. Reasonable and appropriate effort is made to ensure that the content of courses corresponds with the descriptions in the University's Programme and Course Listings.
