General Principles

1. The University's course numbering system is as follows:

Lower-division courses (UK RQF Level 3) normally taken in the first year of the US undergraduate degree, but sub-HE in the UK system	100-199	3000-3999
Lower- division courses (UK FHEQ Level 4) normally taken in the second year of the US undergraduate degree	200-299	4000-4999
Upper- division courses (UK FHEQ Level 5) normally taken in the third year of the US undergraduate degree	300-399	5000-5999
Upper- division courses (UK FHEQ Level 6) normally taken in the fourth year of the US undergraduate degree	400-499	6000-6999
Postgraduate-level courses (UK FHEQ Level 7) taken in a Masters degree	500-599 600-699	7000-7999 (codes apply from Sept 2013)
