

DOUBLE MAJORS POLICY: UNDERGRADUATE

Introduction

1. An undergraduate may complete the requirements of two majors and receive one US degree with those two majors. The student's official academic transcript will indicate one US degree conferred with two majors, and the student will receive one diploma.

General Principles

2. Only one of the majors can be awarded for the UK degree and recorded on the UK degree certificate. Students must nominate their chosen UK degree on their application for graduation.
3. Where students are completing a double major, at least 16 US / 64 UK Level 6 credits must be unique to each major and cannot have been used in any minor or in the liberal arts core. These credits must include Senior Dissertation or Project for each major.
4. For double majors completing minors, three of the courses on the minor must not overlap with either of the major requirements.
5. Students completing two majors will need to complete more than 120 US/480 UK credits.

6. Students may not be registered for more than two majors and cannot be awarded for a degree recognising more than two majors.
